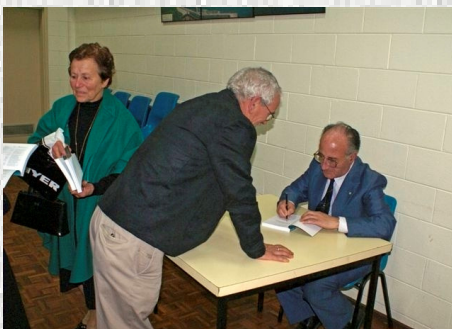


Meeting with His Excellency, Mr. Jurek Juszczuk – Australia’s High Commissioner to Malta.
